*As part of Biodiversity Week 2019*



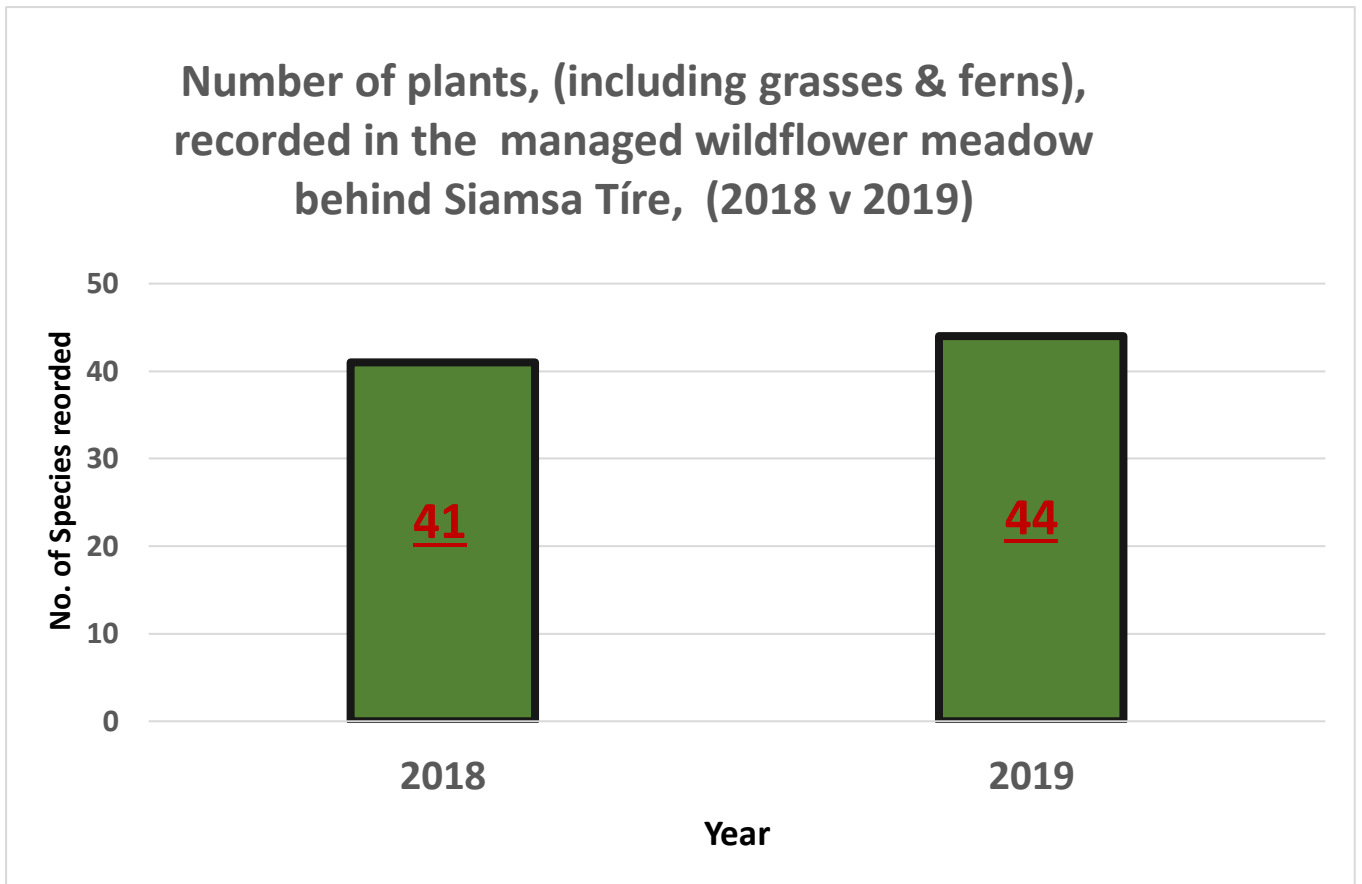
Since the plant survey that took place in 2018, the number of species recorded has increased by 3. (2018 = 41, 2019 = 44).
