This panel will support work in our theatre spaces and gallery, contributing to a vibrant programme rooted in Irish culture, performance, and the visual arts.

Panel members will be engaged on a casual, as-needed basis, working alongside our in-house technical team to deliver a wide range of activities, including performances, touring productions, and visual arts installations.

Work may include:

- Assisting with get-ins, fit-ups, and get-outs
- General stage and backstage support
- Operating lighting, sound, and audio-visual systems
- Supporting visiting companies and artists
- Assisting with stage management where required
- Installation and deinstallation of exhibitions in our gallery spaces

Role Overview

Panel members will provide technical support across performance and visual arts activities, working under the direction of the Technical / Production team.

Skills & Experience

We are particularly interested in hearing from individuals with experience in one or more of the following areas:

- Theatre production (lighting, sound, stage management)
- Venue technician or backstage experience
- Audio-visual systems and digital media

- Visual arts installation and artwork handling
- Rigging of lighting, sound, or AV equipment

Desirable experience includes:

- Familiarity with lighting control systems (e.g. Strand Neo, ETC Eos)
- Experience using sound desks (analogue or digital, e.g. M32) and other audio equipment (e.g. wired/wireless microphones, amplifiers and stage monitors)
- Understanding of the rigging and focusing of lighting fixtures, both generic and intelligent.
- Knowledge of QLab or similar playback software
- Experience working at height and/or holding a valid MEWP certification
- Basic maintenance and troubleshooting of technical equipment

- Able to respond flexibly to changing workloads
- Strong team player with a collaborative approach
- Comfortable working evenings and weekends as required
