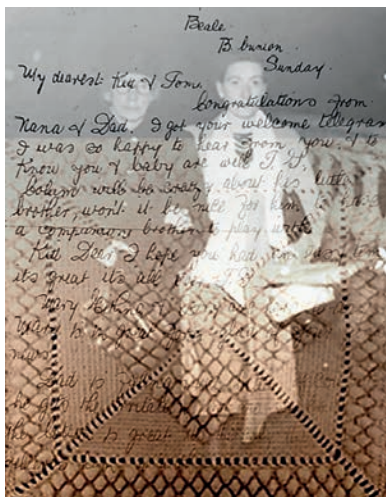
Threading Memories

Gráinne Mulligan

This exhibition is an exploration of intergenerational memory on the maternal side of Gráinne's family. Explored through an examination of gender craft in Kerry in the context of contemporary art.

Both Gráinne's mother and grandmother worked with thread and made crochet, lace, tapestries and clothes. Her grandmother's quilt, which she crocheted over 100 years ago in

Beale in North Kerry, acts as a repository of the memory of the hands that made it and the bodies it covered in life and death. Gráinne's work is materialised in paintings drawings and thread sculptures, the latter, a visual metaphor for maternal mitochondrial DNA. It has involved research into the patterns and history of crochet and lace in Kerry. She also uses Ekphrasis, a rhetorical device, where writing and poetry informs her paintings.

LASTA Youth Arts Festival Exhibition

Following an open call in the summer, the LASTA Youth Arts Festival will include **Backspace**, an exhibition of artworks that celebrates a return to slowness in an age of instant images, prepackaged experience, and mindless consumption. Through these analogue works, observation becomes radical and seemingly outdated media become a vehicle for scrutiny and resistance.

At the advent of the internet, Craig McDaniel and Jean Robertson understood that 'through painting, one is subscribing to a world that is less frenetic in the glut of information being consumed...a world where the construction of meaning is more deliberate.' The rat race has become a sprint. In an age where we feel like we are constantly playing catch-up, slow art processes are speed bumps that force us to pause and consider elements of humanity which we have learned to overlook.

A backspace is not an erasure or an admission of error. When we backspace – digitally erase – we reflect, retrace, rethink and refine our steps forward.

Founded in 1979, Tralee Art Group has supported and promoted visual arts in Kerry for over four decades. With more than 55 members, the group brings together artists of varying styles, interests and experience, fostering creativity through exhibitions, workshops and community engagement.



Draíocht showcases the breadth of talent within the group, featuring original artworks inspired by nature, memory, imagination and the unique character of Kerry. Each piece offers a personal interpretation of the exhibition's theme of magic and wonder. A wonderful selection of artworks will be on display, with many works available for purchase.

The official opening takes place on Friday 9th October at 6pm. Refreshments will be served and all are welcome.

4th – 21st November

Body of Light

Romio Shrestha

Body of Light presents the visionary work of master artist Romio Shrestha, whose paintings bridge the sacred tradition of Tibetan thangka with a contemporary visual language of light, consciousness, and healing. Drawing on the timeless concept of the "body of light" – a luminous state of awakened awareness found across mystical traditions – Shrestha creates works that invite contemplation and inner reflection.



The illuminated manuscripts of medieval Ireland, such as the Book of Kells, and the sacred paintings of Tibet (thangka) are born from devotion, discipline and a profound understanding of the nature of reality. This exhibition brings these two luminous traditions into conversation – revealing shared symbolic languages, spiritual aspirations, and artistic genius. Handcrafted using crushed mineral pigments – integral to the work – each painting radiates remarkable depth and luminosity.

Visitors are invited to journey through a contemplative space where Celtic spirals and Tibetan mandalas, sacred texts and mantras, saints and bodhisattvas, calligraphy and colour speak to the same timeless quest: to illuminate the mind and awaken the heart.
